

A good education is essential for a stable life. Rappahannock United Way (RUW) works to ensure that local children are prepared for success in school and adults get the skills needed for employment.



Last year, Rappahannock United Way had **26 Volunteers** read to local children during **Facebook Story Time**.

RUW awarded **\$100,000** in local grants to support **Virtual Learning Centers**, helping **712 students**.

The virtual learning centers were instrumental for essential workers who required immediate childcare so they could continue to work throughout the pandemic.

- **Birth to 5 years:** Parents develop positive behaviors that support children (birth-5 years) in achieving developmental milestones.
- **School Readiness:** Children entering school demonstrate social readiness and literacy skills.

- **Workforce Education:** Individuals have the skills, qualifications, and experience relevant to the changing workforce.
